We are looking for an enthusiastic CSE & Youth Empowerment Expert who can support both the work done in the Dance4Life team, as well as in the Right Here Right Now programme.

In 2017 Dance4life developed its Youth Empowerment Model, with the aim to empower young people to lead healthy sexual lives. From this Model came The Journey4Life, a peer-led empowerment curriculum, which is built on social emotional learning components and is currently implemented in 8 countries in Africa, Eastern Europe and Asia. For this position we are primarily looking for someone who is overall responsible for the design and innovation of the context-adaptable and effective Dance4Life youth empowerment model, for adequate contextualization of the (online) Journey4Life towards its network of partners and someone who can support organizations in curriculum development, using the principles of The Journey4Life.

Next to that you will be supporting the Right Here Right Now 2.0 programme for 8 hours a week. A programme that aims for young people in all their diversity to enjoy their sexual and reproductive health and rights in gender-just societies. Within this programme you will be responsible for developing the capacity around youth-led social accountability on Comprehensive Sexuality Education.

## Job description

Your role as CSE & Youth Empowerment Expert consists of the following parts:

- 1. Continuous development of the Dance4Life model and the Journey4life
  - Translate the Dance4Life model into a curriculum (the Journey4Life) including design and revision of training tools, manuals, online and offline learning experiences etc.;
  - Provide technical expertise to partners on the (online) Journey4Life, Social Emotional Learning Components and engaging facilitation techniques;
  - Design and co-creation of content/tools together with young people/trainers4life/consultants
  - Prototype and test products/services;
  - Research and network with organizations/experts of innovative approaches;
  - Make sure the Dance4Life model remains state of the art;
  - You integrate both Rutgers and Dance4Life CSE methodologies where applicable.
- 2. Build capacity on Youth-led social accountability on CSE
  - Design and build capacity trajectory on youth-led social accountability on CSE;
  - Provide support to partners within RHRN to build youth-led social accountability on CSE;



Train local trainers on youth-led social accountability on CSE;
